# CHEERS!

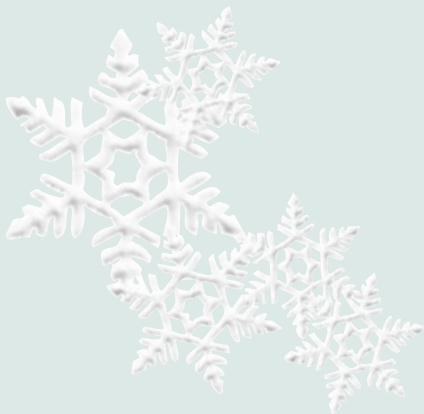

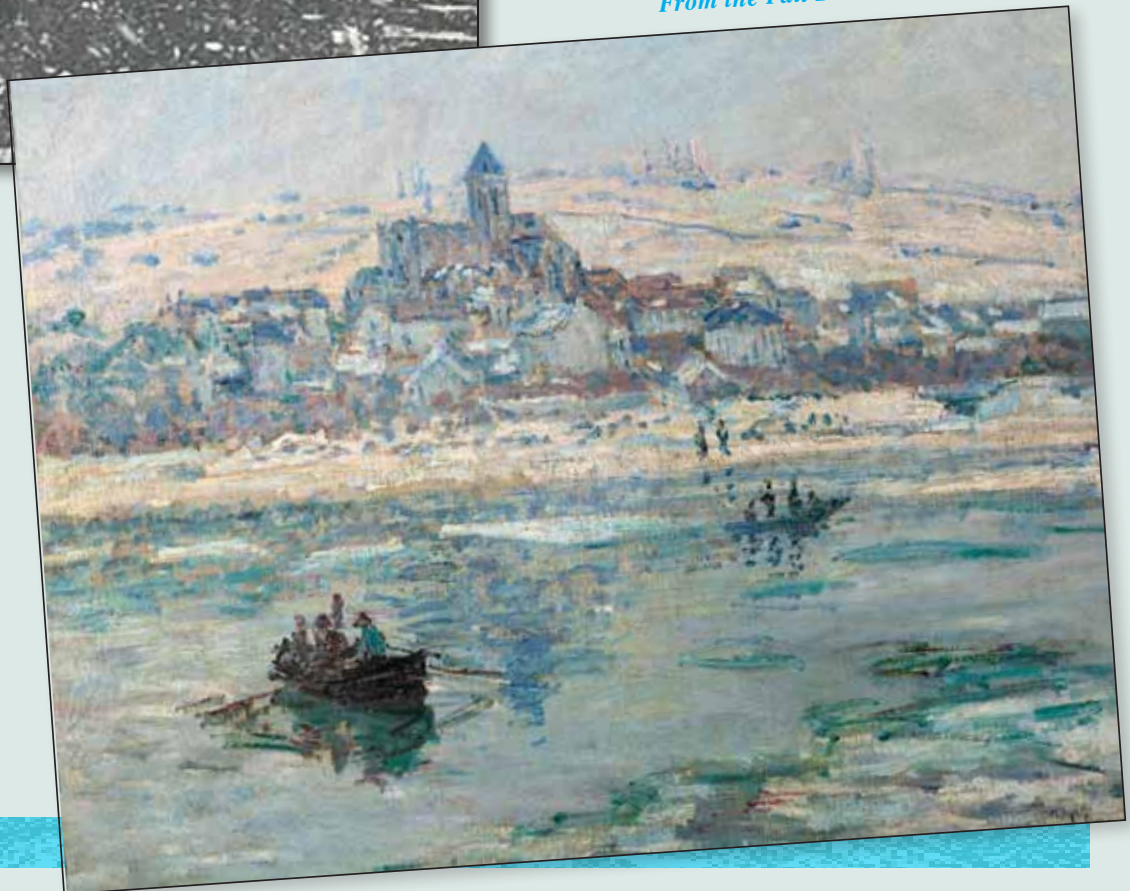

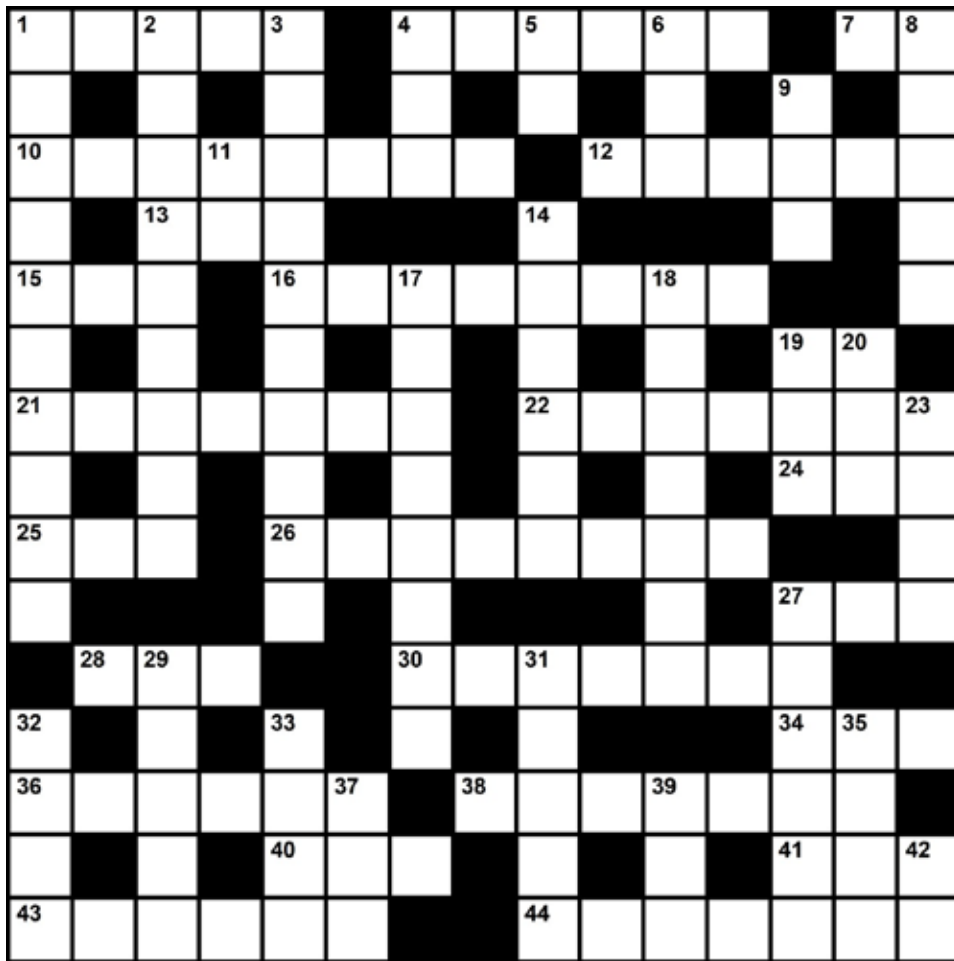

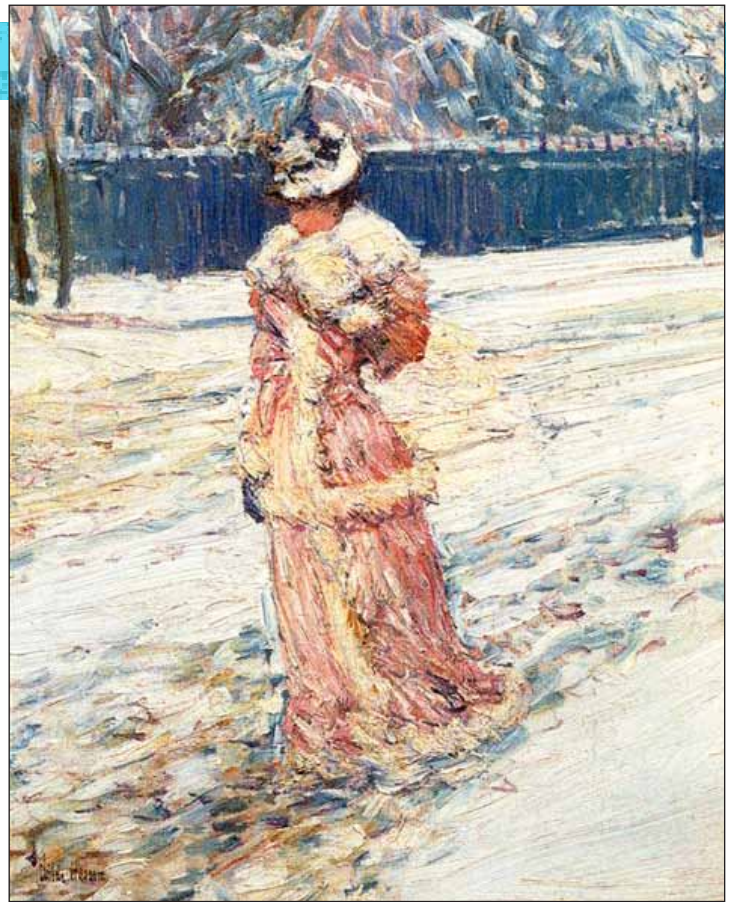

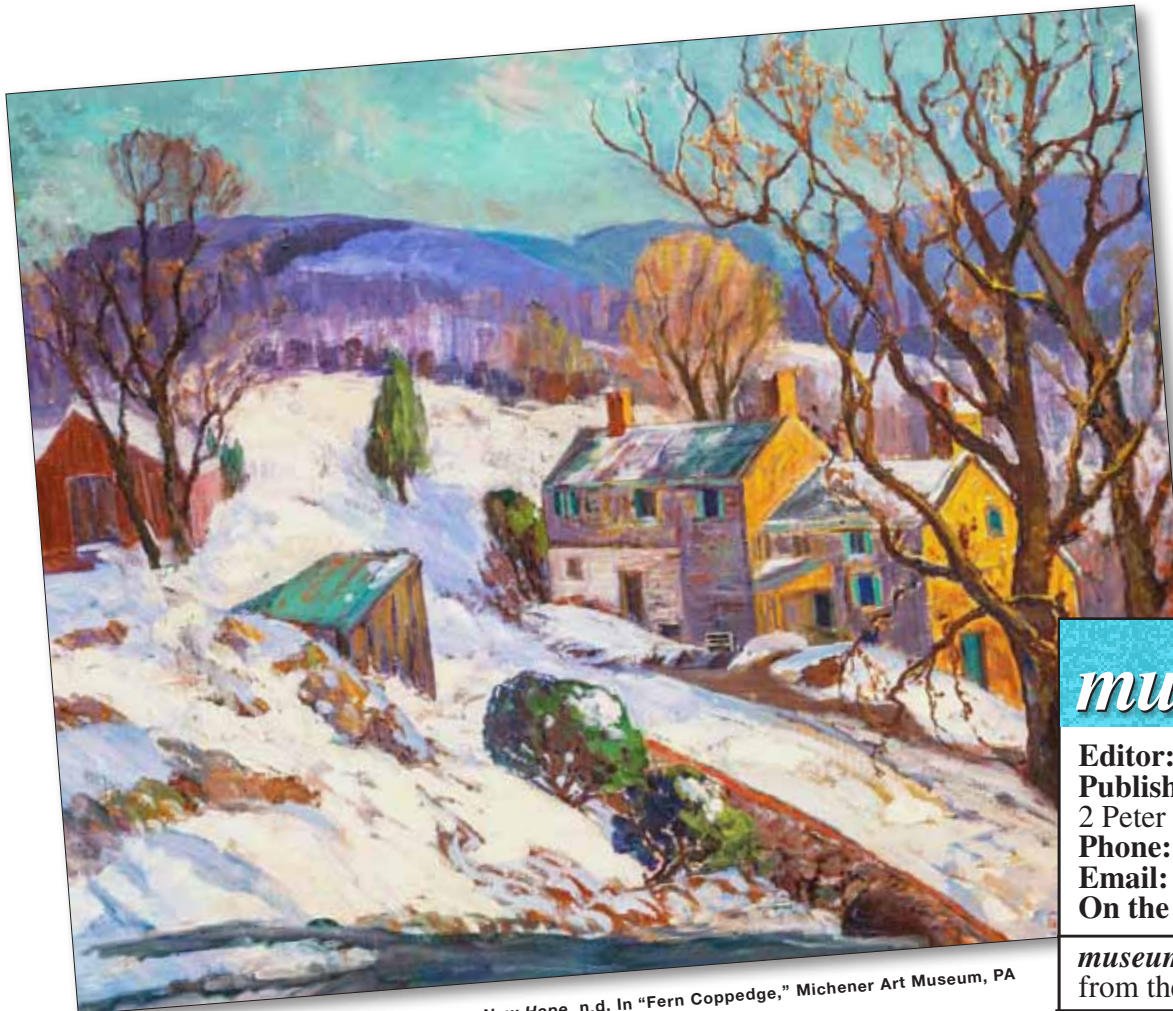
